Roof Over Your Head is a partnership between the Colorado Roofing Association and Habitat for Humanity of Colorado designed to connect local Habitat building projects with professional roofing contractors and suppliers willing to donate materials and labor so that hard working families across Colorado can have a roof over their heads. Together we can BUILD it!

2013 Partnership Goals

PROVIDE 10 hard working, low income families with a roof over their head and the opportunities homeownership brings.

CONNECT CRA members to the needs in their communities and the satisfaction of volunteerism.

PROJECT an image of professional roofing contractors as excellent corporate citizens.

CREATE a long term partnership with Habitat for Humanity and CRA that benefits the missions and goals of both organizations.

How it Works

Habitat for Humanity of Colorado (HFHC) provides Colorado Roofing Association (CRA) with a biannual projected schedule of eligible Habitat projects statewide. CRA provides this schedule to members who volunteer for projects either individually or in teams. HFHC connects the volunteer company with the local Habitat for Humanity affiliate, which provides the company with blueprints and commits to providing adequate notice to the company once the schedule is finalized. The company and CRA then work with suppliers to secure the materials donation, and schedule the work. Eligible projects will be new construction and run typically 13-20 squares with simple designs. HFHC will track donations, provide reporting to CRA, and will act as the central point for communications.
